1961	Establishment of Interelectric AG, Sachseln.
1963	Start of production of electroformed articles, especially cutting blades for the well known BRAUN electric razors.
1968-1969	Development of the maxon range of DC motors with ironless rotor. Patenting of the rhombic winding and its manufacture.
1997	Eleven maxon motors are implemented in the Mars Rover «Sojourner».
2004	The NASA Rovers «Spirit» and «Opportunity» land on Mars. Each of them driven by 35 maxon motors.
2007	Establishment of the medical business unit.
2012	maxon presents a world's first with X drives motors that are configurable online.
2015	maxon launches the MARS business unit (maxon advanced robotics & systems) for the development and production of mechatronical drive systems, including the maxon BIKEDRIVE.
2017	Swiss company zub machine control ag is integrated into the maxon Group.
2018	maxon continues its growth by acquiring the British drive motor manufacturer Parvalux Electric Motors Ltd.
2019	maxon opens its first US production site in Taunton.
